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Pittsburgh receives, first in state, Sensory Learning Program to help sensory processing disorders for children and adults

Sensory Link Pediatric Therapy and Sensory Learning Center of Pittsburgh adds a new option for sensory stimulation to children and adults who are challenged by Learning Disabilities, Attention Deficit Disorders, Sensory Processing, and Autism.

Gibsonia, Pa., October 1, 2009 - **Sensory Link Pediatric Therapy** www.SensoryLink.com is the first center to bring the Sensory LearningSM Program to Pennsylvania. The facility, recently opened in early 2009, offers assistance for pediatric sensory disorders. The Sensory Learning Program is a multi-sensory approach to developmental learning that simultaneously stimulates the visual, auditory and vestibular systems with light, sound, and motion. The program challenges the primary sensory systems to work together and better adapt to multi-sensory input, the foundation of all sensory processing.

Sensory stimulation helps children and adults overcome challenges with Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD), Autism, Learning Disabilities, and Sensory Processing. The program improves perception, understanding, and the ability to learn. Additional benefits include improved sleep patterns, attention to task, self expression and social skills. **Approximately 92% of program participants report improvements when it is used as a stand-alone or an adjunct to traditional therapies.**

“The Sensory Learning Program provides a solid foundation and enhances gains with various therapies such as Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Applied Behavioral Analysis, and Speech,” says Sharon Habovick, Clinical Director of Sensory Link Pediatric Therapy. Here at Sensory Link Pediatric and Sensory Learning Center, **we have accomplished results that were otherwise not experienced without the use of Sensory Learning.**”

Sensory Link Pediatrics’ first patient has been a case study in the effectiveness of the program. His mother, Tammy Crouthamel, of Mars, PA explained, **“We feel that our son can really hear us for the first time. The program appeared to clear away the fog so that he can hear us in our normal voices and respond appropriately.”**

The Sensory Learning Program is comprised of a 30-day regimen. It begins with two 30-minute sessions twice a day for 12 consecutive days. Each session is a new, engaging sensory experience incorporating auditory, visual and equilibrium stimulation to help develop the child’s brain pathways. After the initial 12 in-office days, the remainder of the program is completed at home. Each child is given a portable light device to use in the comfort of their own home twice a day for 20 minutes for the remaining 18 days. The program is typically a one-time intervention.

Sensory Link Pediatric Therapy and The Sensory Learning Center of Pittsburgh offers a cutting edge sensory gym and specialized programming to meet the needs of children experiencing developmental and sensory processing difficulties. This new clinic conveniently located in Gibsonia, PA is off Route 8, 1/8 mile north of the Pennsylvania Turnpike. The Center currently offers Occupational Therapy and for the first time in Pennsylvania, the Sensory Learning Program.
